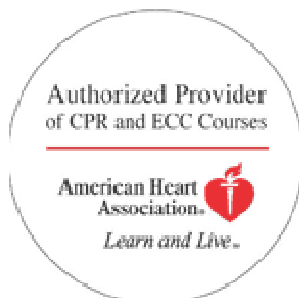

# **AED Management Program**



## AED Maintenance Program Advantages

- **CPR performed in a “Layperson” setting has an average survival rate between 7 to 10%.**
- **AED being deployed out-of-hospital increases chances of survival an average of 84%, if deployed within the first minute of a Sudden Cardiac Arrest survival rate can be as high as 90%.**
- **Most AED’s will not be checked efficiently on a regular basis by staff members and that increases the chances of a Faulty Deployment due to Out-Of-Date Pads or a Dead Battery.**
- **Third Party Representative to manage communications in the event of a faulty device and maintains updates with ECC Guidelines.**
- **An AED Maintenance Program enables a third party to manually check your AED on a Monthly Basis to ensure it is fully functional for an emergency. All activities of Maintenance will be tracked including expiration dates on accessories and CPR/AED Training Records for your facility.**
- **AED accessory purchases for Clients will receive an initial 20% savings from MSRP with the purchase of an AED and Maintenance program. Additional accessory purchases will receive a 15% discount from MSRP.**

*Senate Bill 1185, Idaho Statute Title 9, Chapter 3, Action 5-337 Any person or entity that acquires an AED must ensure that:*

- 1. Expected defibrillator users receive training in its use and care equivalent to the CPR and AED training of the ECC Guidelines set by the AHA, the American Red Cross or similar entities.*
- 2. The defibrillator is maintained and tested according to the manufacturer's operational guidelines.*
- 3. There is involvement of a licensed physician in the site's program to ensure compliance with requirements for training, notification, maintenance and guidelines for use.*
- 4. Any person who renders emergency care or treatment to a person defibrillator to the prescribing physician*
- 5. Any person or entity that acquires an AED shall notify an agent of the emergency communications system or emergency vehicle dispatch center of the existence, location and type of AED.*
- 6. No cause of action shall be maintained which arises from the good faith use of an AED in an emergency setting. This immunity from civil liability does not apply if the acts or omissions amount to gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct.*

## **AED Maintenance Plan**

### **Monthly check and maintenance on AED**

An agent from Keyes To Safety LLC will come to your location on a monthly basis and run through a system check on your AED, that will also include an electrode pad and battery check. Any **updates** (typically costs \$150-\$350) or **maintenance** needed on your AED will be taken care of by Keyes To Safety LLC at no charge unless replacement items are necessary.

- Replacement of Expired pads and battery. If electrode pads or battery become expired, Keyes To Safety LLC will re-order and install new ones for 25% off MSRP.
- Replacement of Used Pads and Battery. Electrode pads can only be used once. If the AED is used during an emergency, new pads will need to be purchased and possibly a new battery. Keyes To Safety LLC will order and install new ones for 25% off MSRP.
- Replacement of defected or malfunctioned pads or battery. If pads or battery become defective or malfunction before expiration date, Keyes To Safety LLC will replace them at no cost to client.
- AED. If the client's defibrillator at any time becomes defected or needs to be replaced, client will be expected to pay for the cost of replacement for a new AED if not covered under manufacturer warranty. If there are parts that need to be replaced besides pads or battery due to normal wear and tear, Keyes To Safety LLC will replace them as long as cost doesn't exceed \$100. If cost is over \$100 client will be expected to pay any additional costs exceeding the \$100.

*\*All AHA Courses through Keyes To Safety LLC for Clients of the AED Maintenance Plan will receive \$5.00 off per person on all Heartsaver CPR w/ AED or Heartsaver First Aid w/ CPR & AED Courses from original Prices, supercedes the group discount pricing of \$3.00 per person and cannot be used in addition with the group discount (maximum discount price is \$5.00).*

Terms and Conditions ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER (EFT) RENEWAL AGREEMENT

This agreement is for a \_\_\_\_ month AED Oversight renewal payment using electronic funds transfer, to be billed SEMI ANNUAL - ANNUALLY (circle one). This is a contract with Keyes To Safety LLC. By signing below I/we agree to continue to have AED fees paid through the debit card or credit card number provided on the completed authorization agreement form for prearranged semi-annual/annual payments (EFT Debits). This will continue until I/we provide a completed written cancellation notice. A 60 day notification prior to the next bill date is required in order to stop the next scheduled billing. Enrollment is subject to account verification. Credit/debit card account must be in good standing.

1. Cancellation of plan – Cancel anytime after initial term agreement. (60 days prior to end of term to avoid billing for renewal term). If cancellation is not made 60 days prior to end of term, the member will be charged for the upcoming term.

2. Insufficient funds – If your automatic withdrawal is returned for insufficient funds, Keyes To Safety LLC will automatically EFT your account an additional \$20.00 per returned item, a notice will be sent about charges within 5 business days. If an automatic withdrawal is rejected by your financial institution due to insufficient funds, a 2nd attempt to draft funds will be made before deeming your term agreement payment unpaid. If the draft is returned unpaid, payment must be sent directly to Keyes To Safety LLC in the form of a money order, cashier’s check, or certified bank check.

3. Keyes To Safety LLC and/or anyone associated with (employees, agents, owner) shall be held free and harmless from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, suits, or expenses (including attorney’s fees), whether based on contract, negligence, or otherwise, as may arise out of any act or failure to act on the part of Keyes To Safety LLC or agent. IN NO EVENT SHALL KEYES TO SAFETY LLC BE LIABLE FOR ANY CONSEQUENTIAL, SPECIAL, INDIRECT, PUNITIVE OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES OR LOSSES THAT YOU MAY INCUR OR SUFFER BY REASON OF THIS AGREEMENT OR ANY PAYMENT EFFECTED OR NOT EFFECTED UNDER THIS AGREEMENT.

4. Adjustment to Amount – Keyes To Safety LLC is hereby authorized to change the amount of the charge to your credit/checking account, provided, however, that we confirm the new payment amount in writing at least 60 days prior to the charge to your credit/checking account. You agree that the payment change confirmation provided to you shall constitute adequate notice of payment change; as such the Electronics Funds Transfer Act and Federal Reserve Board Regulation E may require notice.
